Do our eyes and ears deceive us, or are flowers blooming and birds beginning to sing? Spring is on the way! With the turn of the season, we're looking forward to welcoming warmer weather and watching the results of our winter works - including watching wildflowers flourish and our dune slack pools fill with frog and toad spawn.

We've been working hard during the winter to avoid the spring breeding seasons of ground nesting birds, reptiles and amphibians. For example, we've been scraping turf to expose bare sand to support biodiversity in Braunton Burrows, Devon, and we've been [excavating notches](#) to allow sand to blow through the dunes at Formby, Sefton Coast.

We've also been working closely with communities. In Cornwall, tomorrow is St Piran's day - a legendary historic figure around Penhale. Cornwall Wildlife Trust have run dune-inspired workshops with local artists and now [400 pieces of community art are being exhibited in Perranporth](#). Scroll down to find out more.


